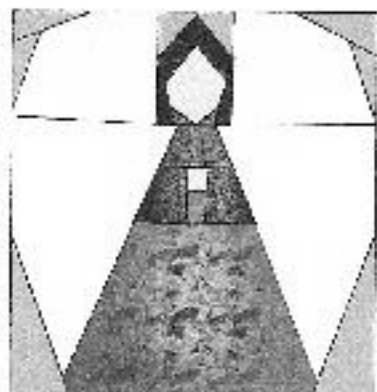


# Celestial Angel and Angel of Hope

## November Holiday Block of the Month

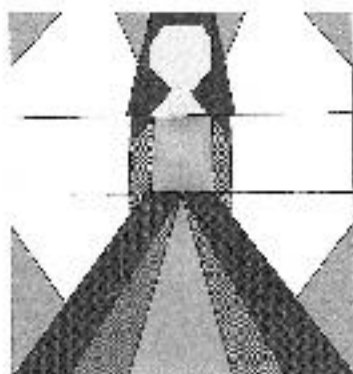


**Celestial Angel**

I believe that when the holidays creep upon us, that miracles can happen. I also believe all of us have a guardian angel looking out for us at some crucial point in our lives.

I've collected angel patterns over the years, I don't remember where I found the top pattern, the Celestial Angel. The bottom pattern, Angel of Hope is a design I created on EQ6 (Electric Quilt Company computer software program).

Both patterns are paper pieced. The Celestial Angel is done in two sections. The Angel of Hope is done in eight sections. It looks complicated, but isn't. Both patterns can be completed in an evening.

### Colors

Background fabrics best for this block should be pale lavender or pale blue.

The remainder of the angel is up to you. You can use holiday fabrics or what ever you have in your scrap pile. Make it interesting.

Block measures 8 1/2" square
